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# **Insurance Details**



# What insurance do I get with my Hockey Wales membership?

Hockey Wales offers a range of insurance to cover your players whilst they are playing for your club. Depending on your membership you will have different levels of cover. For example, if a Hockey Family plays in a Saturday afternoon league match and is injured, they may not be covered.

Various insurance cover is available but the first two of these (Public Liability & Capital Benefits) is the basic insurance that your Hockey Wales membership gives you and your players.

- Public Liability Insurance
- Capital Benefits
- Sports Injury Insurance

The Sports Injury insurance is the additional cover that your club can purchase at very competitive rates. There are currently two options:

#### Option A

- Additional Personal Accident Insurance (Option A)

#### Option B

- Additional Personal Accident & Loss of Earning Insurance (Option B) with various options available within.

**NB:** These prices indicated on the information sheet are for the club, not for individual members.

If you wish to take out any of this additional cover then you can do so by completing the "Voluntary Personal Accident Top up insurance cover proposal".
